"In the absence of adults having meaningful, ongoing, open and honest conversations with young people about sexual behaviour, their bodies, intimacy, respecting themselves... that lack of that conversation enables a very one-sided and dangerously one-sided presentation of sexual behavior, which is the one that they have access to, which is very often, pornography."

7. Exodus Cry is campaigning for required age verification, with ID, on all sites that host porn to help protect children from underage exposure. As a part of this, they have a petition to sign. Do you think this would be an important regulation to pass?

STATISTICS

- According to a 2020 survey, the majority of children are exposed to porn by age 13, with some as young as seven. Most of the time it's unintentional or unwanted.
- In a study of 4,000 heterosexual porn scenes, 35-45% contained an act of physical aggression, mostly against women.
- According to a meta-analysis of 22 studies from 7 countries, porn use is associated with increases in physical aggression.
- An analysis of 12,323 people found that exposure to porn may increase the risk for committing sexual offenses.
